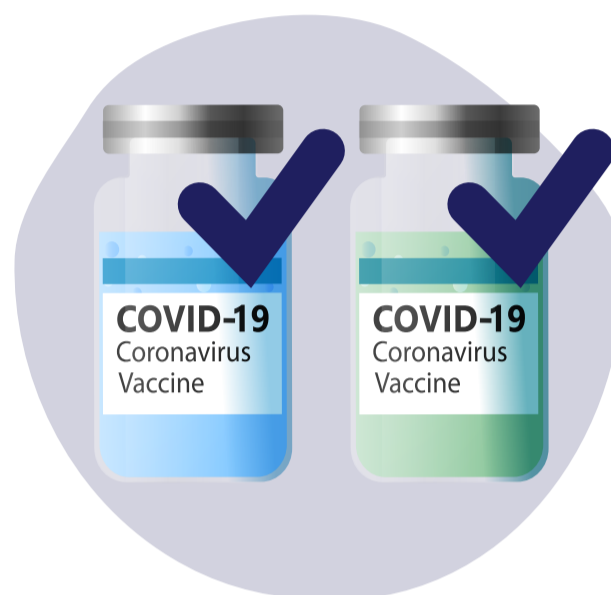

Are the COVID-19 vaccines safe?

Yes! They have been tested and approved by experts and been given to millions of people over the world.



Which vaccine will I get?

The AstraZeneca vaccine is recommended for people over 60 years of age. The Pfizer vaccine is recommended for people under 60 years of age. They are both good vaccines.



Where can I get my COVID-19 vaccine?

You can get your COVID-19 vaccine at a participating GP clinic, NT Health vaccine clinic or Danila Dilba Health Service vaccine clinic.



Do I still need to practice hand hygiene once I have been vaccinated?

Yes! Keep washing your hands, cough into your elbow and stay home when sick.
