COVID-19 Directions (No. 107) 2021: Amendments to COVID-19 Directions (No. 102) 2021

- I, Charles Hawkhurst Pain, Acting Chief Health Officer, under section 52 of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, consider it necessary, appropriate or desirable to take action to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory, declared by instrument entitled "Declaration of Public Health Emergency" dated 18 March 2020, by amending my COVID-19 Directions (No. 102) 2021 as follows, with effect from 12:00 noon on 27 November 2021:
- In direction 2, omit the definitions **aged care facility**, **quarantine period** and **suitable place for quarantine**.
- 2 Directions 3, 4, 9(c), 10 (d) and (e), 23 and 24 are revoked.
- In direction 5, omit "(No. 85)" and insert instead "(No. 106)".
- 4 Direction 13 is revoked and the following inserted instead:
 - 13 A person who exits Katherine under these Directions:
 - (a) must travel directly from Katherine to the approved home quarantine zone; and
 - (b) must wear a face mask as required by my COVID-19 Directions (No. 106) 2021 as if the person were in Katherine.

5 Part 3 is revoked.
