Application for classification as an exempted person or class of persons Northern Territory of Australia *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*

In relation to Public Health Emergency – COVID-19 Chief Health Officer (CHO) Directions

A person or class of persons is exempt from the mandatory 14 day quarantine period if I have granted the person or class of persons an exemption from that direction, in writing, on the grounds that the person or class:

- a. is essential for the proper functioning of the Territory; or
- b. needs an exemption to avoid unusual, undeserved, or disproportionate hardship; or
- c. is governed by a COVID-19 management plan, imposed by the employer of the person or class of persons, to prevent the transmission of COVID-19.

Instructions

1. Fill in this application form.

- A separate application is required for each adult.
- Specify dependent children travelling with you in the form below.
- If travelling as a family/group, submit all applications at once.

2. Submit this application by:

- emailing all pages of your completed form to doh.exempt@nt.gov.au with date of travel in the subject heading

Note: If you hand in your application upon arrival or do not receive exemption prior to travel, you will be required to quarantine as directed until your application has been assessed.

3. Your application will be assessed on its merits by the Chief Health Officer or authorised delegate.

4. You will receive a letter or email from the Chief Health Officer or authorised delegate advising you of the decision of your application.

This information is required from all people who have travelled domestically or internationally and arrived in the Northern Territory from 4pm, 24 March 2020 for the purposes of a direction made by the Chief Health Officer under the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011* for the purposes of managing a notifiable disease, COVID-19

Note: Failure to provide this information is an offence against the Act and may incur a fine of up to \$62,800.

This information is collected and will be used subject to the *Information Act 2002*, for the purposes of assisting the Chief Health Officer to exercise powers and perform functions to prevent or control the spread of a notifiable disease under the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011*, namely the novel coronavirus COVID-19.
